Archbishop Adolfo Tito Yllana was born in Naga City (Philippines) on 6 February 1948.

He was ordained priest on 19 March 1972 for the Archdiocese of Caceres.

He has a Doctorate in Civil and Canon Law. As a student of the Pontifical Ecclesiastical Academy in Rome, he followed the post-graduate studies in International Diplomacy.

Archbishop Yllana entered the Diplomatic Service of the Holy See on 1 February 1984, serving successively in the Apostolic Nunciatures in Ghana, Sri Lanka, Turkey, Lebanon, Hungary and China.

On 13 December 2001, he was appointed Apostolic Nuncio in Papua New Guinea and the Solomon Islands.

On March 30, 2006, he was named Apostolic Nuncio to Pakistan.

On 20 November 2010, he was appointed Apostolic Nuncio in the Democratic Republic of Congo, where he is presently serving.
